THE ST SAMPSONS HIGH SCHOOL (TEMPORARY TRAFFIC)
REGULATIONS, 2008

Made 26th August, 2008
Coming into force 31st August, 2008

THE ENVIRONMENT DEPARTMENT, in the exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Section 1 of the Traffic Temporary Regulations Ordinance, 1950^a, hereby makes the following regulations in order to ascertain the best method of regulating traffic in the locality referred to in these regulations:-

Speed restrictions.

1. Subject to regulation 2, a person shall not drive or ride a vehicle at a speed exceeding 20mph on any of the following public highways in the Parish of Saint Sampson -

Duveaux Road; Baubigny Road; Les Gigands Road; Le Bordage Road; Les Effards Road; Les Hougues Magues Road; Hougues Magues Lane; Les Grandes Capelles Lane; La Vielle Rue; Oatlands Lane; Epinelle Road; Duveaux Lane; Les Sauvagees; Rue de Dol.

Exemptions.

2. Nothing in regulation 1 applies in relation to any vehicle when it is being used -

- (a) for police purposes -
 - (i) in an emergency, or
 - (ii) in pursuit of the driver or rider of any vehicle who is suspected of committing a criminal offence, or
- (b) for fire brigade or ambulance purposes, if the person in charge of the vehicle causes its warning apparatus to be sounded,

to the extent that observance of that regulation would be likely to hinder the use of the vehicle for the purpose of which it is being used.

Interpretation.

3. (1) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948^b applies to the interpretation of these Regulations.

(2) Any reference in these Regulations to an enactment is a reference thereto as from time to time amended, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.

Commencement, citation and period of validity.

4. These Regulations may be cited as the St Sampsons High School (Temporary Traffic) Regulations, 2008 and shall come into force on Sunday 31st August 2008, and will remain in force for a period of 12 months commencing with the date on which they are made.
