THE ROAD TRAFFIC (SPEED LIMITS AND TRIALS)
(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2009*Made**21st August, 2009**Coming into force**25th August, 2009*

THE ENVIRONMENT DEPARTMENT, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by paragraph (1) (c) (iii) of Article X of the Ordinance entitled "Ordonnance relative au Traffic Véhiculaire en cette Ile" of the 2nd March 1929, as amended¹, hereby makes the following regulations:-

Amendment of 1987 Ordinance.

1. The Road Traffic (Speed Limits and Trials) Ordinance, 1987, as amended², is further amended as follows.

2. In Section 2, immediately following paragraph (b), the following paragraph is inserted:-

"(ba) at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on any public highway identified in Part IIA of Schedule 1 to this Ordinance;"

3. In Schedule 1, immediately following Part II the following Part is inserted:-

“PART IIA

20 m.p.h. all year speed limit

4a. The following public highways in the parish of Saint Sampson –

Duveaux Road;
Baubigny Road;
Les Gigands Road;
Le Bordage Road;
Les Effards Road;
Les Hougues Magues Road;
Hougues Magues Lane;
Les Grandes Capelles Lane;
La Vielle Rue;
Oatlands Lane;
Epinelle Road;
Duveaux Lane;
Les Sauvagees;
Rue de Dol.”

Interpretation.

4. (1) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948³ applies to the interpretation of these Regulations.

(2) Any reference in these Regulations to an enactment is a reference thereto as from time to time amended, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.


Citation.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note does not form part of the Regulations)

The purpose of these regulations is to make permanent the temporary 20mph speed limits zone in the vicinity of St Sampson's High and Le Murier Schools.
