THE ST SAMPSONS HIGH SCHOOL (TEMPORARY TRAFFIC) (No. 2)  
REGULATIONS, 2008

*Made*

26<sup>th</sup> August, 2008

*Coming into force*

31<sup>st</sup> August, 2008

THE ENVIRONMENT DEPARTMENT, in the exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Section 1 of the Traffic Temporary Regulations Ordinance, 1950<sup>1</sup>, hereby makes the following regulations in order to ascertain the best method of regulating traffic in the locality referred to in these regulations:-

**One-way street restrictions.**

1. Subject to regulation 2, a person in charge of a vehicle or animal may only drive or ride that vehicle, or cause or permit that animal to proceed, on or along -

- (a) Duveaux Road, Baubigny Road (between Duveaux Lane and Le Bordage Road) in the parish of Saint Sampson, in the direction of South-east to North-west,
- (b) Le Bordage Road, Les Effards Road and Les Hougues Magues Road in the parish of Saint Sampson in the direction of east to west.

**Exemptions.**

2. Regulation 1 does not apply to-

- (a) a cyclist riding or pushing a bicycle within a marked cycle contra-flow lane, or
- (b) a person leading a horse at any point between the junction of the Prison access road with Baubigny Road and a point in Duveaux Road that is 150m east of the junction of Baubigny Road with Duveaux Lane.

**Interpretation.**

3. (1) In these Regulations, "**animal**" means any horse, bovine animal, ass, mule, sheep, pig or goat.

(2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948<sup>2</sup> applies to the interpretation of these Regulations.

(3) Any reference in these Regulations to an enactment is a reference thereto as from time to time amended, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.

**Commencement, citation and period of validity.**

4. These Regulations may be cited as the St Sampsons High School (Temporary Traffic) (No. 2) Regulations, 2008 and shall come into force on Sunday 31<sup>st</sup> August 2008, and will remain in force for a period of 12 months commencing with the date on which they are made.

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

These Regulations are made to ascertain the best method of regulating traffic in the vicinity of the Les Nicolles Schools. The particular purpose of these Regulations is to ascertain the effects of making the above roads one-way (with certain exceptions for cyclists and horses) as part of the traffic management measures for St Sampsons High and Le Murier Schools.
