THE IMPORT DUTIES (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (No.73) ORDER, 1976

The Board of Administration, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by section two and section ten of the Import Duties Act (Bailiwick of Guernsey) 1932, as amended and in implementation of the obligations of the Bailiwick under the provisions of Protocol No.3 annexed to the Treaty relating to the accession of the United Kingdom to the European Economic Community and to the European Atomic Energy Community, hereby orders:-

1. The Import Duties (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (No.70) Order, 1975, as amended (a), is hereby further amended as follows:-

the Second Schedule thereto is amended as shown in the Schedule to this Order.

2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.

3. (1) This Order may be cited as the Import Duties (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (No.73) Order, 1976.

- (2) This Order shall come into operation on the first day of July, nineteen hundred and seventy-six.

3. Delete subheadings 11.02 A.VII., VIII. and IX. together with the corresponding rates of duty and re-number subheading X. as VII.

4. In subheading 11.02 B.I. -
Delete the words "Barley, oats, buckwheat and millet" and insert the words "Barley and oats" ;
delete subheadings a)3. and a)4. together with the corresponding rates of duty ; and
delete subheadings b)3. and b)4. together with the corresponding rates of duty.

5. Delete subheading 11.02 B.II.d) together with the corresponding rates of duty and re-letter subheading e) as d).

6. Delete subheadings 11.02 C.VI., VII. and VIII. together with the corresponding rates of duty and re-number subheading IX. as VI..

7. Delete subheadings 11.02 D. VI., VII. and VIII. together with the corresponding rates of duty and re-number subheading IX. as VI..

8. In subheading 11.02 E.I. -
Delete the words "Barley, oats, buckwheat and millet" and insert the words "Barley and oats" ;
delete subheadings a)3. and a)4. together with the corresponding rates of duty ; and
delete subheadings b)3. and b)4. together with the corresponding rates of duty.

9. Delete subheading 11.02 E.II.d) together with the corresponding rates of duty and re-letter subheading e) as d).

10. Delete subheadings 11.02 F. VII., VIII. and IX. together with the corresponding rates of duty and re-number subheading X. as VII..

11. Insert the symbol "*" against subheading 11.06 A..

12. In heading 11.09 delete the colon and insert "Free", "Free" and "L" respectively in the Full, Preferential and Additional Charge columns ; delete subheadings 11.09 A. and B. together with the corresponding rates of duty.

13. Delete subheadings 17.01 A. and B. together with the corresponding rates of duty and the footnote prefixed by the symbol "+"; and insert the following new subheadings and rates of duty -

14. In subheading 23.02 A.I.b) delete the colon and insert "Free", "Free" and "L" respectively in the Full, Preferential and Additional Charge columns ; delete subheadings 23.02 A.I.b) 1. and 2. together with the corresponding rates of duty and delete the footnote prefixed by the symbol "+".

15. Delete the text of subheading 23.02 A.II.a) and insert "Of which the starch content does not exceed 28% by weight, and of which the portion that passes through a sieve with an aperture of 0.2 mm does not exceed 10% by weight or otherwise the portion that passes through the sieve has an ash content, calculated on the dry product, equal to or more than 1.5% by weight".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Order, which comes into operation on 1st July 1976, makes further amendments to the Second Schedule annexed to the Import Duties (Bailiwick of Guernsey)(No.70) Order, 1975, which sets out the 1976 Guernsey tariff.

The Schedule contains textual amendments in accordance with the obligations of the Bailiwick to align to the EEC's Common Customs Tariff.
