

HEREAS by the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1971 dated the 16th March, 1971, (a), the importation into Guernsey of goods consigned from a place outside the United Kingdom, the Island of Jersey, the other Islands of the Bailiwick of Guernsey or the Isle of Man is prohibited unless under the authority of a licence granted by or on behalf of the States Board of Administration.

NOW THEREFORE the States Board of Administration, in exercise of its powers under Article 2 of the above-mentioned Order, hereby authorises as follows:-

1. The Open General Import Licence made by the States Board of Administration and dated the eleventh day of November, nineteen hundred and seventy-five, (b), as amended is hereby further amended as follows:-

(a) In Schedule 1:-

- (i) the letter "J" shall be omitted in the second column in respect of the following entries:-

55.07	cotton gauze
ex 61.09	corsets, corset-belts, suspender-belts, brassieres, braces, suspenders, garters and the like, wholly or mainly of woven cotton.

(ii) the following entries shall be omitted:-

" ex 61.07	ties, bow-ties and cravats, wholly or mainly of cotton. J"
" ex 61.10	gloves, mittens and mitts, wholly or mainly of woven cotton. J"
" ex 61.11	made-up accessories for articles of apparel (for example, dress shields, shoulder and other pads, belts, muffs, sleeve protectors, pockets, removable linings), wholly or mainly of cotton. J"
" ex 62.01	travelling rugs and blankets, wholly or mainly of cotton. J"
" ex 92.11	combined sound recorders and reproducers. NC"

(b) In Schedule 5 there shall be inserted the following entries;

" ex 61.01	men's and boys' suits of wool. Romania, Czechoslovakia, German Democratic Republic and Berlin (East)."
" ex 62.03	Sacks and bags made from polyethylene strip or polypropylene strip. Republic of Korea".

(c) In the second column of Schedule 5, in relation to tariff headings 55.05 and 56.07, "Portugal" shall be omitted.

2. This Amendment shall take effect on the eighteenth day of August, nineteen hundred and seventy-six, and may be modified or revoked at any time by the States Board of Administration.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Amendment to the Open General Import Licence but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

The effect of this Amendment is that cotton gauze, certain cotton articles of apparel and travelling rugs and blankets of cotton, originating in Japan and consigned to Guernsey under the authority of the Government of Japan may no longer be imported under the authority of the Licence. Such goods originating in Japan may be imported under the authority of the Licence if consigned to Guernsey from another Member State of the European Economic Community.

Combined sound recorders and reproducers originating in and consigned to Guernsey from the Non-Community Area may now be imported under the Authority of the Licence.

Men's and boys' suits of wool originating in Romania, Czechoslovakia or the German Democratic Republic and Berlin (East), may no longer be imported under the authority of the Licence.

Sacks and bags made from polyethylene strip or polypropylene strip originating in the Republic of Korea may not be imported under the Licence, irrespective of their country of consignment.

Cotton yarn not put up for retail sale and woven fabrics of man-made fibres originating in Portugal, may be imported under the authority of the Licence if consigned to Guernsey from the Community area.
