**THE SOCIAL SECURITY DEPARTMENT**, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 10 and 35 of the Health Service (Benefit) (Guernsey) Law, 1990 as amended<sup>1</sup>, section 1 of the Health Service (Benefit) (Limited Lists) Ordinance, 2004<sup>2</sup> and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

**Amendment**

1. In the Schedule to the Health Service (Benefit) (Limited List) (Pharmaceutical Benefit) Regulations, 2004<sup>3</sup>, as amended add the rows set out in Schedule 1 to these Regulations, under the appropriate headings.

**Extent**

2. These Regulations shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.

**Interpretation**

3. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948<sup>4</sup> applies to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.

**Citation**

4. These Regulations may be cited as the Health Service (Benefit) (Limited List) (Pharmaceutical Benefit) (Amendment) Regulations, 2010.
