

THE IMPORT DUTIES (MEDITERRANEAN COUNTRIES)

(BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1976

The Board of Administration, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by sections two, seven and nine of the Import Duties Act (Bailiwick of Guernsey) 1932, as amended and in implementation of the obligations of the Bailiwick under the provisions of Protocol No.3 annexed to the Treaty relating to the accession of the United Kingdom to the European Economic Community and to the European Atomic Energy Community, hereby orders :-

1. The Import Duties (Mediterranean Countries) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1976 (a) is hereby amended as follows :-

in the proviso to section 2 thereof shall be inserted the following new sub-paragraph :-

"(b) subject to the provisions of sub-paragraph (a) above, in the case of goods of Spain falling in any heading of Chapters 25 to 99 of the Second Schedule to the Import Duties (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (No.70) Order, 1975 as amended (b), up to and including the 30th. June, 1977, duty shall not be charged under this Order at a rate exceeding that charged immediately prior to the accession of the United Kingdom to the European Economic Community;"

and the existing sub-paragraphs (b) and (c) shall be re-lettered (c) and (d).

2. (1) This Order may be cited as the Import Duties (Mediterranean Countries) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1976.
- (2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948 shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
- (3) This Order shall be deemed to have come into force on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and seventy-six.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

This Order, which became effective on 1 January, 1976, makes provisions for the rate of duty chargeable on industrial goods of Spain until the end of the accession transition period (30 June, 1977), to be that which applied in the Bailiwick prior to the accession of the United Kingdom to the EEC, if that rate is lower than the current full rate.
