The Post Office (Overseas Letter Post) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order, 1975

THE STATES POST OFFICE BOARD, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by sections thirteen, sixteen, nineteen and sixty-eight of the Post Office (Guernsey) Law, 1969, as amended(a), hereby orders:-

Amendments  
to Order

1. The Post Office (Overseas Letter Post) Order, 1973, as amended(b), is hereby further amended as follows:-

- (a) in Part I and Part III respectively of the Arrangement of Sections thereof the entries "5. Insured boxes." and "32. Insured boxes." are repealed;
- (b) section five thereof is repealed;
- (c) in subsection (4) of section eight thereof the words ", an insured box," are repealed;
- (d) in subsection (1), in paragraph (b) of subsection (4) and in paragraphs (a) and (b) of subsection (5) respectively of section fourteen thereof the words "or an insured box" are repealed;
- (e) in paragraph (c) of subsection (4) of section fourteen thereof the words "or insured box" are repealed;
- (f) in paragraphs (a) and (b) respectively of section twenty-eight thereof the words "or an insured box" are repealed;
- (g) section thirty-two thereof is repealed;
- (h) in section thirty-three thereof the words ", insured box" are repealed;

- (i) in subsection (3) of section thirty-five thereof the words "or an insured box" are repealed;
- (j) in subsection (4) of section thirty-five thereof the words "or insured box" and "or insured box (as the case may be)" are repealed;
- (k) in subsection (5) of section thirty-five thereof the words "or insured box", "or insured box (as the case may be)" and "or insured boxes (as the case may be)" are repealed;
- (l) in subsection (1) of section forty-two thereof the definitions of the expressions "insured letter" and "insured box" are repealed and the following definition is substituted therefor -

"insured letter" means any insured letter which is for the time being transmissible under the provisions of the Universal Postal Union Agreement for the exchange of insured letters for the time being in force, and the detailed Regulations made thereunder;"

- (m) in subsection (1) of section forty-two thereof in the definition of the expression "postal packet" the words ", and an insured box," are repealed;
- (n) in the Second Schedule thereto -

- (i) Part 1 is repealed and the following Part is substituted therefor:-

" PART 1

Rates of Postage under section two and subsection (2) of section three

- (a) Printed packet (other than an All-up Newspaper):

Weight not exceeding 20 g.	5p
exceeding 20 g. but not exceeding 50 g.	6p
exceeding 50 g. but not exceeding 100 g.	7p
exceeding 100 g. but not exceeding 250 g.	11p
exceeding 250 g. but not exceeding 500 g.	20p
exceeding 500 g. but not exceeding 1 kg.	35p
exceeding 1 kg. but not exceeding 2 kg.	65p

- (b) Printed packet complying with section 11(1)(b):

exceeding 2 kg. but not exceeding 3 kg.	£1.00
exceeding 3 kg. but not exceeding 4 kg.	£1.35
exceeding 4 kg. but not exceeding 5 kg.	£1.65 "

(ii) paragraph 1 of Part 4 is repealed and the following paragraph is substituted therefor:-

"1. (a) Printed packet:

Weight not exceeding 20 g.	6p
exceeding 20 g. but not exceeding 50 g.	8p
exceeding 50 g. but not exceeding 100 g.	10p
exceeding 100 g. but not exceeding 250 g.	16p
exceeding 250 g. but not exceeding 500 g.	28p
exceeding 500 g. but not exceeding 1 kg.	48p
exceeding 1 kg. but not exceeding 2 kg.	80p

(b) Printed packet complying with section 11(1)(b):

exceeding 2 kg. but not exceeding 3 kg.	£1.20
exceeding 3 kg. but not exceeding 4 kg.	£1.60
exceeding 4 kg. but not exceeding 5 kg.	£2.00 "

(iii) Part 5 is repealed;

- (o) in sub-paragraphs (a), (b) and (c) respectively of paragraph 2 of Part 1 of the Third Schedule thereto the words ", Insured Box" are repealed;
- (p) in the Fifth Schedule thereto all the entries relating to paragraph 6 are repealed.

Citation. 2. This Order may be cited as The Post Office (Overseas Letter Post) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order, 1975.

Commencement. 3. This Order shall come into force on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and seventy-six.
