

GUERNSEY STATUTORY INSTRUMENT 1976 No. 51

The Public Health (Notifiable Diseases)

Order, 1976

Made	24th August , 1976
Laid before the States	, 1976
Coming into Operation	1st September , 1976

THE STATES BOARD OF HEALTH, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of section one of Article VI of the Public Health Ordinance, 1936, as amended (a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

1. The following infectious or contagious diseases, that is to say:-

Lassa fever; and
rabies;

are hereby declared to be notifiable diseases within the meaning of section one of Article VI of the Public Health Ordinance, 1936, as amended.

2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948 (b), shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.

3. This Order may be cited as the Public Health (Notifiable Diseases) Order, 1976.

4. This Order shall come into force on the first day of September , nineteen hundred and seventy-six.
