THE HOME DEPARTMENT, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 4(3) and 66 and paragraph 10 of Schedule 3 to the Data Protection (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2001^a, and after consultation with the Data Protection Commissioner in accordance with section 66(3) of that Law, hereby makes the following Order:-

Revocation of S.I. No. 24 of 2009.

1. The Data Protection (Processing of Sensitive Personal Data) (Elected Representatives) Order, 2004, registered as Guernsey Statutory Instrument No. 24 of 2009 and signed by Geoffrey Mahy as Minister of the States Home Department on 1st May, 2009, is revoked.
