THE BOVINE SEMEN (IMPORTATION OF GUERNSEY BREED SEMEN) ORDER, 1976

THE STATES COMMITTEE FOR AGRICULTURE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section two A of The Bovine Semen and Artificial Insemination Ordinance, 1957, as amended, (a) hereby orders:-

1. The Committee hereby specifies the Guernsey breed of bovines as a breed of bovines from which semen may be imported under the provisions of section two A of The Bovine Semen and Artificial Insemination Ordinance, 1957, as amended.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948 (b), shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as The Bovine Semen (Importation of Guernsey Breed Semen) Order, 1976.
4. This Order shall come into force on the fifteenth day of September nineteen hundred and seventy-six.
