THE HOME DEPARTMENT, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 18(5) and 66 of the Data Protection (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2001^a, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Revocation of S.I. No. 23 of 2009.

1. The Data Protection (Notification and Notification Fees) (Amendment) Regulations, 2004, registered as Guernsey Statutory Instrument No. 23 of 2009 and signed by Geoffrey Mahy as Minister of the States Home Department on 1st May, 2009, are revoked.

Interpretation.

2. (1) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948^b applies to the interpretation of these Regulations.

(2) Any reference in these Regulations to an enactment is a

reference thereto as from time to time amended, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.

Citation and commencement.

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Data Protection (Notification and Notification Fees) (Revocation) Regulations, 2009 and shall come into force on the October, 2009.
