THE STATES COMMITTEE FOR AGRICULTURE, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by section one and by sub-section (2) of section seven of the Rabies (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1975 (a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment of section 9 of the Order of 1976

1. Section nine of the Rabies Order, 1976(b), is hereby amended as follows:-

- (a) in subsection (1) thereof, immediately after the words "in the Islands", there shall be inserted the words "or at anchor or moored in the territorial waters adjacent to any of the Islands";
- (b) in subsection (6) thereof, the words and comma "the Islands," shall be deleted and the words and comma "in the Islands or in the territorial waters adjacent to any of the Islands," shall be substituted therefor.

Citation and commencement

2. This Order may be cited as the Rabies (Amendment) Order, 1976, and shall come into force on the fifteenth day of September, nineteen hundred and seventy-six.

Explanatory Note

(This Note does not form part of the Order, but is intended to explain its general purport).

The effect of this Order is to extend to any vessel which is moored or at anchor in the territorial waters adjacent to the Islands of Guernsey, Sark, Herm or Jethou the provisions of Section 9 of the Rabies Order 1976 relating to the detention of animals on board vessels in harbour.
