THE IMPORT DUTIES (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (No.75) ORDER, 1976

The Board of Administration, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by section two and section ten of the Import Duties Act (Bailiwick of Guernsey) 1932, as amended and in implementation of the obligations of the Bailiwick under the provisions of Protocol No.3 annexed to the Treaty relating to the accession of the United Kingdom to the European Economic Community and to the European Atomic Energy Community, hereby orders:-

1. The Second Schedule to the Import Duties (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (No.70) Order, 1975, as amended (a), is hereby further amended as follows:-
 - (a) in subheading 04.04 A.I. -
delete "202.89 UA" and insert "208.97 UA" ;
delete "222.89 UA" where it occurs and insert "228.97 UA" ;
delete "250.89 UA" in both cases and insert "256.97 UA" ; and
delete "270.89 UA" and insert "276.97 UA" ;
 - (b) in subheading 04.04 E.I.b)1.aa) delete "202.00 UA" and insert "207.00 UA".
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. (1) This Order may be cited as the Import Duties (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (No.75) Order, 1976.
(2) This Order shall come into operation on the sixteenth day of September, nineteen hundred and seventy-six.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Order, which comes into operation on 16th September, 1976, further amends the Second Schedule to the Import Duties (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (No.70) Order, 1975, which sets out the 1976 Guernsey Tariff.

Changes are made in the free-at-frontier values expressed in units of account in the description of certain cheeses of heading 04.04, in pursuance of obligations under the Common Agricultural Policy of the EEC.
