

The Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Payment of Approved Suppliers) (Amendment)  
(No. 2) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1976

THE STATES INSURANCE AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section twelve of the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Guernsey) Law, 1972, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Interpretation

1. (1) In these regulations, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them, that is to say:-

"basic price", in relation to the ingredients of any item of pharmaceutical benefit, has the same meaning as is assigned to that expression by paragraph (1) of regulation one of the principal regulations;

"the Law" means the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Guernsey) Law, 1972;

"the principal regulations" means the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Payment of Approved Suppliers) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1976;

and any other expressions have the same meaning as in the Law.

(2) Except where the context otherwise requires, any reference in these regulations to any enactment or regulations shall be construed as including a reference to that enactment or those regulations, as the case may be, as amended, repealed, replaced, revoked, extended or applied, by or under any other enactment or by any other regulations.

(3) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of these regulations as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.

Amendments of regulation two of the principal regulations

2. Paragraph (1) of regulation two of the principal regulations is hereby further amended as follows -

(a) in sub-paragraph (b) thereof, the words "eight per centum" are hereby repealed and the words "twenty and one half per centum" are hereby substituted therefor;

- (b) in sub-paragraph (d)(iii) thereof, the words "twenty-one pence" are hereby repealed and the words "twenty-five pence" are hereby substituted therefor.

Further additional supplemental payment to approved suppliers

3. An approved supplier shall be paid out of the Guernsey Health Service Fund in respect of each item of pharmaceutical benefit -

- (a) which was supplied by him under the Law during the period commencing on the first day of March, nineteen hundred and seventy-six, and ending on the thirty-first day of May, nineteen hundred and seventy-six; and
- (b) in respect of which payment was made out of that Fund upon the receipt by the Authority of a certificate relating to any part of that period and issued by the body appointed by the Authority to calculate the sum payable to approved suppliers in respect of pharmaceutical benefit supplied by them under the Law;


in addition to that payment and in addition to any other payments previously made to him under regulations made under the Law, a sum equal to eighteen per centum of the basic price of the ingredients of that item.

Citation and commencement

4. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Payment of Approved Suppliers) (Amendment) (No.2) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1976.

(2) These regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation on the first day of September, nineteen hundred and seventy-six.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport).

These regulations further amend the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Payment of Approved Suppliers) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1976, by increasing the amounts payable to approved suppliers in respect of each item of pharmaceutical benefit supplied by them under the Law and to provide for an additional supplemental payment to be made to approved suppliers out of the Guernsey Health Service Fund in respect of drugs and medicines supplied by them between the 1st March, 1976 and 31st May, 1976.
