The Commonwealth Preference (Standstill Area)

(Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1976

THE BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by subsection (2) of section nine of the Import Duties Act (Bailiwick of Guernsey), 1932, as amended, hereby orders:-

1. The Commonwealth Preference (Standstill Area) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1975 (a) is hereby amended as follows:-

Schedule 1 thereto is revoked and Schedule 1 to this Order is substituted therefor.

2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as The Commonwealth Preference (Standstill Area) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1976 and shall be deemed to have come into force on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and seventy-six.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Order amends Schedule 1 to The Commonwealth Preference (Standstill Area) Order, 1975 which names the countries entitled to benefit from the continuance of the preferential treatment which applied on 1 January 1972. Goods of the countries removed from the Schedule are now able to benefit from tariff preference arrangements applied by the Community.
