THE ENVIRONMENT DEPARTMENT, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 12 of the Land Planning and Development (Fees and Commencement) Ordinance, 2008^a and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Amendment of Schedule 1.

1. (1) The Table of Fees in Schedule 1 to the Land Planning and Development (Fees and Commencement) Ordinance, 2008 is amended as follows.

(2) In category 5L (relating to the placing on land of a moveable structure), in the third column of that category, for the figure "125" substitute "42 (up to a maximum of £85 per application)".

Interpretation.

2. (1) Any reference in these Regulations to an enactment is a


reference thereto as from time to time amended, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.

(2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948^b applies to the interpretation of these Regulations.

Citation and commencement.

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Land Planning and Development (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations, 2010 and shall come into force on the 28th day of January, 2010.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Land Planning and Development (Fees and Commencement) Ordinance, 2008 to change the required fee to accompany an application for planning permission for the placing on land of a moveable structure from £125 for each such structure to £42 for each such structure subject to a maximum of £85 per application.
