

**The Public Records (Fees for Registration and Certified  
Copies of Documents) Regulations, 2008**

*Made* , 2008  
*Coming into operation* 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2009  
*Laid before the States* , 2008

**THE TREASURY AND RESOURCES DEPARTMENT**, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 1 and 5 of the Fees, Charges and Penalties (Guernsey) Law, 2007<sup>a</sup> and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:-

**Registration fees for documents**

1. In section 1 of the Public Records (Fees for Registration and Certified Copies of Documents) Ordinance, 1960<sup>b</sup> ("the 1960 Ordinance") -

- (a) in paragraph (a) for "£30" substitute "£45",
- (b) in paragraphs (b) and (c) for "£2.50" substitute "£3.50".

**Fees for certified copies of documents**

2. In section 2 of the 1960 Ordinance -

- (a) in paragraph (a) for "£2" substitute "£2.50",
- (b) in paragraph (b) for "£4" substitute "£4.50".

**Fees for uncertified copies of registered documents**

3. In section 2A of the 1960 Ordinance -

- (a) in paragraphs (a) and (b)(ii) for "£1" substitute "£1.25",
- (b) in paragraph (b)(i) for "£3" substitute "£3.50".

**Fees in respect of documents creating charge on land**

4. In paragraphs (a) and (b) of section 2B of the 1960 Ordinance for "£25" substitute "£30".


**Citation**
