
The Water Supply (Control) (Repeal)
(Guernsey) Regulations, 1976

Made	7th October, 1976
Laid before the States	1976
Coming into Operation	7th October, 1976

THE STATES EMERGENCY COUNCIL, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by subsection (1) and subsection (4) of section two of the Emergency Powers (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1965, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Regulations:-

1. The Water Supply (Control) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1976, the Water Supply (Control) (No.2) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1976 and the Water Supply (Control) (No.3) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1976 are hereby repealed.
2. These Regulations shall have effect in the Island of Guernsey.
3. These Regulations may be cited as the Water Supply (Control) (Repeal) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1976.
4. These Regulations shall come into force on the seventh day of October, nineteen hundred and seventy-six.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

These Regulations repeal the Regulations made by the Emergency Council giving power to the President of the Water Board to ration metered supplies, to the Board to refuse to supply water to new premises and authorizing the use of stand-pipes.
