**The Traffic Temporary (Longue Hougue Lane) Regulations, 2010**

Made

*3<sup>rd</sup>* August, 2010

Coming into operation

7<sup>th</sup> August, 2010

**THE ENVIRONMENT DEPARTMENT**, in the exercise of the powers conferred upon it by article X of the Ordonnance relative au Traffic Vehiculaire en cette Ile, 1929<sup>1</sup> and section 1 of the Traffic Temporary Regulations Ordinance, 1950<sup>2</sup>, hereby makes the following regulations in order to ascertain the best method of regulating traffic in the localities referred to in these regulations:-

**Amendment to 1989 Ordinance.**

1. The Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1989,<sup>3</sup> is amended by-

(a) inserting, immediately after paragraph 1 in Part VIII of Schedule 1, the following paragraph -

"2. Longue Hougue Lane. This paragraph applies to all vehicles and animals, except for access to premises on Longue Hougue Lane."

## **Interpretation.**

2. (1) In these Regulations, unless the context requires otherwise -

**"Department"** means the Environment Department;

**"enactment"** means any Law, Ordinance or subordinate legislation;  
and

**"subordinate legislation"** means any regulation, rule, order, rule of court, resolution, scheme, byelaw or other instrument made under any enactment and having legislative effect.

- (2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948<sup>4</sup> applies to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
- (3) Unless the context requires otherwise, references in these Regulations to any enactment are references thereto as amended, varied, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.

## **Citation**

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic Temporary (Longue Hougue Lane) Regulations, 2010.

## **Commencement and Expiry**

4. These Regulations shall come into force on the 7<sup>th</sup> August, 2010 and shall cease to have effect –



#### EXPLANATORY NOTE
