THE COMMERCE AND EMPLOYMENT DEPARTMENT, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 8(1)(a) of, and paragraph 3 of the Schedule to, the Employment and Discrimination Tribunal (Guernsey) Ordinance, 2005^a, hereby makes the following Order:-

Amendment of article 1 of principal order.

1. Article 1 of the Employment Protection (Summoning of Witnesses and Documents) Order, 2006^b is amended by deleting the expression "(a), (b) or (c)".

Interpretation.

2. (1) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948^c applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.

This Order amends the Employment Protection (Summoning of Witnesses and Documents) Order, 2006 to ensure that it applies to the hearing and determination of a complaint relating to contravention of the Minimum Wage Law, 2009 (such complaints would be permitted by section 16(1)(c) and (d) of the Employment Protection Law, 1998, as amended).
