**The Employment Protection (Recoverable Costs)  
(Amendment) Order, 2010**

**THE COMMERCE AND EMPLOYMENT DEPARTMENT**, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 8(1)(a) of, and paragraph 6 of the Schedule to, the Employment and Discrimination Tribunal (Guernsey) Ordinance, 2005<sup>a</sup> hereby makes the following Order:-

**Amendment of principal order.**

1. The Employment Protection (Recoverable Costs) Order, 2006<sup>b</sup> is amended as follows –

- (a) in article 1, delete the expression "(a), (b) or (c)", and
- (b) in article 9(2), for the word "at", substitute the word "it".

**Interpretation.**

2. (1) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948<sup>c</sup> applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.

(2) Any reference in this Order to an enactment is a reference thereto as from time to time amended, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.

**Citation.**

3. This Order may be cited as the Employment Protection (Recoverable Costs) (Amendment) Order, 2010.

**Commencement.**

4. This Order comes into force on the 1<sup>st</sup> October, 2010.
