

GUERNSEY STATUTORY INSTRUMENT

**The Traffic Temporary (Market Street and Le Petit
Carrefour) Regulations, 2009**

Made 27th November, 2009
Coming into operation 1st December, 2009

THE ENVIRONMENT DEPARTMENT, in the exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 1 of the Traffic Temporary Regulations Ordinance, 1950^a, hereby makes the following regulations in order to ascertain the best method of regulating traffic in the localities referred to in these regulations:-

Amendment to 1989 Ordinance.

1. The Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1989,^b is amended by-

- (a) inserting, immediately after paragraph number 13 in Part I of Schedule 1, the following paragraph -

"13A. Market Street and Market Square: This paragraph applies to all vehicles and animals, except –

(a) any delivery vehicle in the street or square between the hours of 1 am and 10 am for the purpose of loading or unloading goods, and

(b) any vehicle –

(i) in the street or square between the hours of 8 am and 10 am, and

(ii) in the charge of a person in possession of a disabled person's badge.

In this paragraph "**delivery vehicle**" means a vehicle which is designed or constructed for use wholly or mainly for the carriage of goods.", and

(b) deleting entries number 39 (Market Street, including Market Square) and number 56 (Le Petit Carrefour) respectively of Part I of Schedule 2.

Interpretation.

2. (1) In these Regulations, unless the context requires otherwise -

"**Department**" means the Environment Department;

"**enactment**" means any Law, Ordinance or subordinate legislation; and

"**subordinate legislation**" means any regulation, rule, order, rule of court, resolution, scheme, byelaw or other instrument made under any enactment and having legislative effect.

(2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948^c applies to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.

(3) Unless the context requires otherwise, references in these Regulations to any enactment are references thereto as amended, varied, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.

Citation

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic Temporary (Market Street and Le Petit Carrefour) Regulations, 2009.

Commencement and Expiry


4. These Regulations come into force on the 1st December, 2009 and cease to have effect –

- (a) at the end of the period of 12 months commencing with the date on which they are made, or

(b) on any earlier date determined by order of the Department.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

Market Street, including Market Square, and Le Petit Carrefour were designated as one-way streets under the 1989 Ordinance. In order to ascertain the best method of providing an appropriate level of access as two-way roads, the Department is temporarily amending the 1989 Ordinance so that Le Petit Carrefour, Market Street, and Market Square become two-way and that, except by permit, access to Market Street and Market Square will be restricted to delivery vehicles between 1 am and 10 am and to disabled badge holders between 8 am and 10 am.
