**The Road Traffic Temporary (Clearways) (Fountain Street)
Regulations, 2009**

Made

18th December, 2009

Coming into operation

24th December, 2009

THE ENVIRONMENT DEPARTMENT, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 1 of the Traffic Temporary Regulations Ordinance, 1950, as amended^a, hereby makes the following Regulations in order to ascertain the best method of regulating traffic in this Island –

Amendment to the Road Traffic (Clearways) Ordinance, 1999^b.

1. In Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Clearways) Ordinance, 1999 for paragraph 3 substitute –

"3. Fountain Street, At all times
Saint Peter Port

This paragraph does not apply between the hours of 6.00 p.m and 7.30 a.m, 9.30 a.m and 12 noon, or 2.00 p.m and 4.00 p.m to any

7.30 a.m, 9.30 a.m and 12 noon, or 2.00 p.m and 4.00 p.m to any person causing or permitting a delivery vehicle to stop in a loading bay for no longer than is necessary in order to unload goods from and load goods into that vehicle."

Interpretation.

2. (1) In these Regulations, unless the context requires otherwise -

"**enactment**" means any Law, Ordinance or subordinate legislation and

"**subordinate legislation**" means any regulation, rule, order, rule of court, resolution, scheme, byelaw or other instrument made under any enactment and having legislative effect.

(2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948^c applies to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.

(3) Unless the context requires otherwise, references in these Regulations to any enactment are references thereto as amended, varied, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic Temporary (Fountain Street) Regulations, 2009.


Commencement and Expiry

- (a) at the end of the period of 12 months commencing with the date on which they are made, or
- (b) on any earlier date determined by order of the Department.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

This Regulation makes provision for the temporary amendment of the hours of operation of the clearway which operates in Fountain Street, St Peter Port.
