The Boarding Permits Fees Order, 2009

THE COMMERCE AND EMPLOYMENT DEPARTMENT, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 17 of the Tourist Law, 1948^a as amended^b and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Fee payable by the holder of a boarding permit

1. The holder of a boarding permit shall pay to the Department -
 - (a) within 14 days of the granting of the permit a fee in the following amount -
 - (i) in the case of premises classified by the Board under section 13 of the Law as guest accommodation -
 - (A) for a permit valid for the period 1 April 2010 to 31 March 2011, or part thereof, a fee of £5-50 multiplied by the maximum number of persons for whom the holder of the permit is permitted, in accordance with the condition attached to it pursuant

to section 5(2) of the Law, to provide sleeping accommodation for reward; and

- (B) for a permit valid for the period 1 April 2011 to 31 March 2012, or part thereof, a fee of £7-25 multiplied by the maximum number of persons for whom the holder of the permit is permitted, in accordance with the condition attached to it pursuant to section 5(2) of the Law, to provide sleeping accommodation for reward,
 - (ii) in any other case, a fee of £7-25 multiplied by the maximum number of persons for whom the holder of the permit is permitted, in accordance with the condition attached to it pursuant to section 5(2) of the Law, to provide sleeping accommodation for reward; and
- (b) at any time a fee in an amount equivalent to the amount of any costs incurred by the Department, or any person acting on its behalf, for any purposes connected with the taking into account of any matters required for the classification and grading of premises to which the permit relates in accordance with section 13 of the Law.

Interpretation.

2. (1) In this Order:

- (a) "**the Law**" means the Tourist Law, 1948; and
- (b) "**Department**" means the Commerce and Employment Department.

(2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948^c applies to the interpretation of these Regulations.

(3) Any reference in these Regulations to an enactment is a reference thereto as from time to time amended, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.

Repeal.

3. The Boarding Permit Fees Order, 2008 is repealed^d.

Citation and commencement.

4. This Order may be cited as the Boarding Permit Fees Order, 2009 and shall come into force on 1st April, 2010.
