

The Waste Disposal Charges Regulations 2009

Made , 2008
Coming into operation 1st January, 2009
Laid before the States , 2008

THE PUBLIC SERVICES DEPARTMENT, in its capacity as Waste Disposal Authority¹ under, and in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 32(2)(c) of, the Environmental Pollution (Guernsey) Law, 2004² and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Waste Disposal Charges.

1. The charges set out in the schedule to these Regulations are prescribed for the purposes of section 32(2)(c) of the Environmental Pollution (Guernsey) Law, 2004 in respect of the disposal of waste of the types, and at the sites, referred to therein.

Revocation.

2. The Waste Disposal Charges Regulations (No. 2), 2008³ are hereby revoked.

Interpretation.


3. (1) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948⁴ applies to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.

(2) Any reference in these Regulations to an enactment is a reference thereto as from time to time amended, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.

Citation and commencement.

4. These Regulations may be cited as the Waste Disposal Charges Regulations, 2009 and shall come into force on the 1st January, 2009.

SCHEDULE
WASTE DISPOSAL CHARGES

The following charges, or rates of charge, apply in relation to the disposal of the types of waste at the sites indicated, subject to a minimum charge of £10 for each weighed load.

- (a) *Disposal at Mont Cuet -*
 - (i) standard waste including green waste - £126.60 per tonne,
 - (ii) waste subject to contamination - £189.90 per tonne,
 - (iii) inert waste - £253.20 per tonne,
 - (iv) notifiable special waste - £253.20 per tonne,
non-notifiable pre-sorted special waste - £126.60 per tonne,
 - (v) commercial green waste £16.60 per tonne,
 - (vi) private household waste - £1 per bag.

- (b) *Disposal at Longue Hougue -*
 - (i) standard waste - £11.00 per tonne,
 - (ii) soil with turf/vegetation - £52.75 per tonne,
 - (ii) reload charge - £15,
 - (iii) black bag waste - £1 per bag (private householder)

- (c) *Disposal at Waste Segregation Facility -*
 - (i) standard waste - £126.60 per tonne,
 - (ii) commercial recyclables - £40 per tonne,
 - (ii) reload charge - £50.00

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations, made by the Public Services Department in its capacity as Waste Disposal Authority under the Environmental Pollution (Guernsey) Law, 2004, prescribe the charges payable in order to dispose of waste at the Authority's waste disposal sites as from 1st January 2009.
