The Tomatoes (Control of Importation) (Revocation) Order, 2010

Made 12th October 2010
Coming into operation 12th October 2010
Laid before the States 2010

THE COMMERCE AND EMPLOYMENT DEPARTMENT, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 13 of the Import and Export (Plant Health) Ordinance, 1982, as amended,^a and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Revocation.

1. The Tomatoes (Control of Importation) Order, 2010^b is revoked.


Interpretation.

2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948^c applies to the interpretation of this Order.

Citation and commencement.

3. This Order may be cited as the Tomatoes (Control of Importation) (Revocation) Order, 2010 and shall come into force on 12th October 2010.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order revokes the Tomatoes (Control of Importation) Order, 2010. This has the effect of removing the prohibition, set out in that order, on the importation into Guernsey, Herm and Jethou of tomatoes, other than pre-packed tomatoes, that originate in Spain (including the Canary Islands) and Morocco.
