THE IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1971

AMENDMENT TO OPEN GENERAL IMPORT LICENCE

WHEREAS by the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1971 dated the 16th March, 1971, (a), the importation into Guernsey of goods consigned from a place outside the United Kingdom, the Island of Jersey, the other Islands of the Bailiwick of Guernsey or the Isle of Man is prohibited unless under the authority of a licence granted by or on behalf of the States Board of Administration.

NOW THEREFORE the States Board of Administration, in exercise of its powers under Article 2 of the above-mentioned Order, hereby authorises as follows:-

1. The Open General Import Licence made by the States Board of Administration and dated the eleventh day of November, nineteen hundred and seventy-five, (b), as amended is hereby further amended as follows:-

(a) In Article 6, for paragraph (4) there shall be substituted the following:-

"(4) Goods comprised in any entry in Schedule 5 hereto may not be imported into Guernsey under the authority of this Licence if they originate in a country set out in the second column in relation to each entry in the first column of the Schedule."

(b) In the second column of Schedule 5, in relation to tariff heading 55.05 there shall be inserted "Portugal; Spain;" before "Taiwan" and in relation to tariff heading 56.07 there shall be inserted "Portugal;" before "Taiwan".

(c) In Schedule 1 the following entries shall be omitted:-

- " ex 06.01 Bulbs, rhizomes, corms and tubers, dry. E"
- " ex 27.07 Benzole. RO"
- " 27.09 Petroleum oils and oils obtained from bituminous minerals, crude. RO"
- " ex 27.10 Petroleum oils and oils obtained from bituminous minerals, other than crude and other than mixed alkylenes; preparations, other than those containing mixed alkylenes, not elsewhere specified or included, containing not less than 70% by weight of petroleum oils or of oils obtained from bituminous minerals, these oils being the basic constituents of the preparations. RO"
- " 27.11 Petroleum gases and other gaseous hydrocarbons. RO"
- " ex 27.13 Paraffin wax; Petroleum waxes. RO"
- " ex 29.01 Hydrocarbons other than acetylene, dipentene, divinylbenzene, methylstyrene, pinene, terpinolene, tetra-phenylbutadiene. RO"

(d) In Schedule 1, for the entry relating to tariff heading 85.21 there shall be substituted the following:-

- " ex 85.21 Thermionic, cold cathode and photo-cathode valves and tubes other than television receiver cathode-ray monochrome tubes; photocells; mounted piezo-electric crystals; diodes, transistors and similar semiconductor devices. E"

(e) In Schedule 4 there shall be inserted the following entries:-

- " ex 85.15 Colour television receivers of the domestic or portable type or designed or adapted for fitting to motor vehicles (including those incorporating gramophones or other sound reproducers); monochrome television receivers with cathode-ray tubes whose bulb diagonal measurement is 15in. or less (including those incorporating gramophones or other sound reproducers)."
- " ex 85.21 Television receiver cathode-ray colour tubes."

2. This Amendment shall take effect on the seventeenth day of March, nineteen hundred and seventy-six, and may be modified or revoked at any time by the States Board of Administration.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Amendment to the Open General Import Licence but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

The effect of this Amendment is that certain cotton yarn originating in Portugal or Spain, and woven fabrics of man-made fibres originating in Portugal may not be imported under the Licence, irrespective of their country of consignment. Certain horticultural products and television receiver cathode-ray monochrome tubes originating in or consigned to Guernsey from the Eastern Area and certain mineral oils and their products originating in, or consigned to Guernsey from Romania, may now be imported under the authority of the Licence.

Domestic or portable colour television receivers, television receiver cathode-ray colour tubes and monochrome television receivers with cathode-ray tubes of 15in. or less (consigned to Guernsey from the Non Community Area) may not now be imported under the Licence. Hitherto only such tubes and certain transistorised broadcast receivers from the Eastern Area could not be imported under the Licence.
