**The Data Protection (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2001  
(Commencement) Order, 2010**

**THE HOME DEPARTMENT**, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 66 and 74(3) of the Data Protection (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2001<sup>a</sup> hereby makes the following Order -

**Commencement of Law.**

1. Sections 54(1)(b) and (3) and 56 of the Data Protection (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2001 shall come into force on the 1st March, 2010.

**Interpretation.**

2. (1) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948<sup>b</sup> applies to the interpretation of this Order.


**Citation.**
