The Social Insurance (Residence and Persons Abroad) (Guernsey) (Amendment) Regulations, 2009

THE SOCIAL SECURITY DEPARTMENT, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 1, 6, 8, 15, 98 and 116 of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1978, as amended¹, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment.

1. In paragraph (4) of Regulation 4 of the Social Insurance (Residence and Persons Abroad) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978² delete the words “at the rate” and replace with the words “in the amount”.

Interpretation.

2. (1) Except where the context otherwise requires, any reference in these Regulations to any enactment or regulations shall be construed as including a reference to that enactment or those regulations, as the case may be, as amended, repealed, replaced, revoked, extended or applied, by or under any other enactment or by any other regulations.

(2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948³ applies to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.

Citation.

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Social Insurance (Residence and Persons Abroad) (Guernsey) (Amendment) Regulations, 2009.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These regulations amend the Social Insurance (Residence and Persons Abroad) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978 to decouple the amount of the 'overseas voluntary contribution' from the upper annual income/earnings limits and make it a sum of money.
