**The Non-Contributory Pensions (Additional
Classes of Persons) Ordinance, 1967**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-eighth day of June, nineteen hundred and sixty-seven, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by subsection (5) of section two of the Non-Contributory Pensions (Guernsey) Law, 1955(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:—

1. The classes of persons to whom the Non-Contributory Pensions (Guernsey) Law, 1955, as amended, applies are hereby varied by the insertion, immediately after paragraph (g) of subsection (1) of section two of the said Law, of the following additional paragraphs lettered “(h)” and “(i)”—

Two additional classes of persons to whom Law of 1955 shall apply.

“(h) a woman who is pregnant, other than such a woman who is living with her husband or is, or is deemed by the Authority to be, co-habiting with a man as his wife:

(i) a woman who is the mother of an illegitimate child—

(i) during the period of seven weeks commencing with the week in which the confinement occurs and for this purpose the expression “confinement” shall mean labour resulting in the issue of a living child or labour after twenty-eight weeks of pregnancy resulting in the issue of a child whether alive or dead:

(ii) during any other period if she is wholly or partly maintaining that child and the child is a member of the same household;

other than such a woman who is living with her husband or is, or is deemed by the Authority to be, co-habiting with a man as his wife.”.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Non-Contributory Pensions (Additional Classes of Persons) Ordinance, 1967.
