**The Non-Contributory Pensions
(Implementation) (Amendment)
Ordinance, 1956.**

THE STATES LEGISLATION COMMITTEE,
under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon
them by paragraph (3) of Article sixty-six of the
Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948, and in pursuance of
the Resolution of the States of the 25th day of July,
1956, hereby order:—

1. The Non-Contributory Pensions (Implementa-
tion) Ordinance, 1955 (hereinafter referred to as “ the
principal Ordinance ”) is hereby amended as
follows—

- (a) items (a), (b) and (c) of paragraph 2 of Part I of
the First Schedule to the principal Ordinance
are hereby repealed and the following items
substituted therefor—

“(a) For a husband and wife ...	71	0
(b) For a person who is living alone, or is a householder and, as such, is directly responsible for rent and household necessities	42	0
(c) For any other person, being		
(i) aged 20 years or over ...	37	0

(iv) aged 11 years or over but less than 16 years	17	0

(b) items (a) and (b) of paragraph 3 of Part I of the First Schedule to the principal Ordinance are hereby repealed and the following items substituted therefor—

“(a) For a husband and wife		
(i) of whom one is such a person	91	6
(ii) of whom both are such persons	106	6
(b) For any other such person, being		
(i) aged 20 years or over ...	63	0
(ii) aged 18 years or over but less than 20 years	45	6
(iii) aged 16 years or over but less than 18 years	37	6
(iv) above school leaving age but aged less than 16 years	29	0”.

2. This Ordinance and the principal Ordinance may be cited together as the Non-Contributory Pensions (Implementation) Ordinances, 1955 and 1956.

3. This Ordinance shall come into force on the 14th day of September, 1956.
