**The Non-Contributory Pensions
(Implementation) (Amendment)
Ordinance, 1963.**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-eighth day of November, nineteen hundred and sixty-two, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section three and section fourteen of the Non-Contributory Pensions (Guernsey) Law, 1955(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:—

1. The Non-Contributory Pensions (Implementation) Ordinance, 1955, as amended(b), is hereby further amended as follows:—

- (a) in section (b) of sub-paragraph (1) of paragraph 4 of Part I of the First Schedule thereto, the figures and letters “7s. 6d.” are hereby repealed and the figures and letters “15s. od.” are hereby substituted therefor;

- (b) in section (b) and section (c) of paragraph 3 of Part II of the First Schedule thereto, the words "four hundred" where they occur in those sections are hereby repealed and the words "six hundred" are hereby substituted therefor;
- (c) in paragraph 6 of Part II of the First Schedule thereto the full stop at the end of that paragraph is hereby repealed and a colon is hereby substituted therefor and immediately thereafter is hereby inserted the following Proviso—

"PROVIDED that the cash value of any board or lodging or both which a person is enjoying under and in pursuance of a contract of service shall not be disregarded.";

- (d) immediately after sub-paragraph (1) of paragraph 8 of Part II of the First Schedule thereto, there is hereby inserted the following additional sub-paragraph numbered "1(A)"—

"1(A) For the purposes of the last preceding sub-paragraph, there shall be included in the net weekly earnings of a person the cash value of any board or lodging or both which that person is enjoying under and in pursuance of a contract of service.";

- (e) in section (a) of sub-paragraph (2) of paragraph 8 of Part II of the First Schedule thereto, the figures and letter "20s." are hereby repealed and the figures, letters and

words "30s. plus one-half of the next twenty complete shillings." are hereby substituted therefor;

- (f) in section (b) of sub-paragraph (2) of paragraph 8 of the First Schedule thereto, the figures and letter "15s." are hereby repealed and the figures, letters and words "25s. plus one-half of the next ten complete shillings." are hereby substituted therefor;
- (g) paragraph 9 of Part II of the First Schedule thereto is hereby repealed and the following paragraph is hereby substituted therefor—

"9. (1) Subject to the provisions of the next succeeding sub-paragraph, where the applicant is a householder, or the husband or wife of a householder, his resources shall be taken to include a contribution towards the expenses of the household from any member thereof who is not a dependent of his of an amount of 10s. a week save that where the resources of the said member—

- (a) amount to 150s. a week or less but more than 120s. a week, the amount of the contribution shall be taken to be 8s. a week;
- (b) amount to 120s. a week or less but more than 90s. a week, the amount of the contribution shall be taken to be 6s. a week;

(c) amount to gos. a week or less, no contribution shall be taken to be so included.

(2) Where the members of the household of an applicant or of the husband or wife of an applicant are husband and wife and are not dependants of the applicant, instead of any contribution or contributions towards the expenses of the household from the husband or the wife or both of them which would be taken to be included in the resources of the applicant under sub-paragraph (i) of this paragraph, there shall be taken to be so included a joint contribution from the husband and the wife of an amount equal to double the amount of the contribution, if any, which, but for the provisions of this paragraph, would have been taken to be so included—

(a) in the case where only the husband or the wife has any resources, in respect of the husband or the wife, as the case may be;

(b) in the case where both the husband and the wife have resources, in respect of whichever of them has the greater amount of resources.”.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Non-Contributory Pensions (Implementation) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1963, and this Ordinance and the Non-Contributory Pensions (Implementation) Ordinances, 1955 to 1962, may be cited together as the Non-Contributory Pensions (Implementation) Ordinances, 1955 to 1963.
