**The Official Publications Ordinance,
1950.**

The States Legislation Committee in pursuance of the "Loi par rapport à la publication des Annonces Officielles (1936)," under and by virtue of the powers conferred on them by paragraph (3) of Article 66 of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948, hereby order:—

1. Where, under the provisions of any enactment in force immediately before the commencement of this Ordinance, publication of any matter is required to be made in both of the newspapers published locally and known respectively as the "Guernsey Evening Press" and the "Star", that requirement shall henceforth be deemed to be satisfied by publication, in the manner specified by such enactment, of that matter in the "Guernsey Evening Press" and "Guernsey Star".

2. The Ordonnance par rapport à la Publication des Annonces Officielles of the 21st day of March, 1936, and the Ordonnance par rapport à la Publication des Annonces Officielles (1940), may hereinafter respectively be cited as the Official Publications Ordinance, 1936, and the Official Publications Ordinance, 1940, and those Ordinances, the Official Publications Ordinance, 1948, and this Ordinance may be cited together as the Official Publications Ordinances, 1936 to 1950.

3. This Ordinance shall come into force on the 19th day of April, 1950.
