ORDINANCE OF THE STATES

**An Ordinance prescribing the Regulations in accordance
with the provisions of 'The Road Traffic (Compulsory Third-
Party Insurance) (Alderney) Law, 1950.**

The States in pursuance of the provisions of Article 12 and 14 of 'The Road Traffic (Compulsory Third-Party Insurance) (Guernsey) Law, 1936', as applied to the Island of Alderney by the 'Road Traffic (Compulsory Third-Party Insurance) (Alderney) Law, 1950', sanctioned by Order of His Majesty in Council on the Third day of February 1950, have made the following Regulations:-

- (1) The Ordinances of the Royal Court of Guernsey set out in the Schedule hereto, either in their present form or as modified from time to time, shall have effect in the Island of Alderney, subject to the adaptations and modifications set out in the next succeeding section hereof.
- (2) In the application of the said Ordinances to the Island of Alderney, unless the context otherwise requires:-
 - (a) A reference to the Island or to the States of Guernsey or any expression bearing either of these meanings shall include a reference to the Island or to the States of Alderney, as the case may be;
 - (b) A reference to 'The Road Traffic (Compulsory Third-Party Insurance) (Guernsey) Law, 1936' shall, in relation to the Island of Alderney, be deemed to be a reference to that Law as modified by 'The Road Traffic (Compulsory Third-Party Insurance) (Alderney) Law, 1950';
 - (c) In Regulation 12, the words:- "issuing authority" means the Board' shall be substituted the words' "issuing Authority" means the Treasurer of the States of Alderney;
 - (d) Regulations 23, 24 and 25 shall not apply to the Island of Alderney;
 - (e) Regulation 26 shall be read as though the word 'summary' were omitted.
