The Fees (Alderney) Ordinance, 1990

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the fifth day of September, 1990 and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 1 of the Fees (Alderney) Law, 1989^a, section 1 of the Tourist (Alderney) Law (Fees) Ordinance, 1983, section 16(1) of the Liquor Licensing Ordinance, 1966 to 1989, section 1(4) of the Motor Vehicles (International Circulation) (Alderney) Ordinance, 1961, section 8 of the Dangerous Weapons (Alderney) Ordinance, 1965, section 16 of the Alderney Road Traffic and Public Highways Ordinances, 1966 to 1988, section 2(4) of the Hired Motor Vehicles (Alderney) Ordinance, 1972, section 6 of the Licensing of Passenger Boats (Alderney) Ordinance, 1954 and 1972, sections 1 and 2 of the Marriage Fees (Alderney) Ordinance, 1978 and section 1(2)(b) of the Nursing and Residential Homes (Registration and Occupation) (Alderney) Law, 1987^b, hereby order: –

New fees payable.

1. (1) The fees payable to the States in respect of any licence, permit or matter described in the second column of Part I of the Schedule to this Ordinance shall be the amounts specified in relation to that licence, permit or matter in the third column of Part I of the said Schedule.

(2) The fees payable to the States in respect of any licence, permit or matter described in the second column of Part II of the Schedule to this Ordinance shall be the amounts specified in relation to that licence, permit or matter in the fourth column of Part II of the said Schedule, in substitution for the amounts specified in the third column thereof.

(3) The fees payable to the States in respect of any licence, permit or matter described in the second column of Part III of the Schedule to this Ordinance shall be the amounts specified in relation to that licence, permit or matter in the fourth column of Part III of the said Schedule, in substitution for the amounts specified in the third column thereof.

(4) The fees payable to officiating ministers or to the Registrar in respect of any copy, entry, certificate, notice licence, attendance or matter described in the second column of Part IV of the Schedule to this Ordinance shall be the amounts specified in relation to that copy, entry, certificate, notice, licence, attendance or matter in the fourth column of Part IV of the said Schedule, in substitution for the amounts specified in the third column thereof.

(5) The fees payable to the States in respect of any registration described in the second column of Part V of the Schedule to this Ordinance shall be the amounts specified in relation to that registration in the third column of Part V of the said Schedule.

Interpretation.

2. (1) Any reference in this Ordinance to any other enactment shall, except where the context otherwise requires, be construed as including a reference to that enactment as amended, repealed, or replaced, extended or applied by or under any other enactment including this Ordinance.

(2) In this Ordinance "**the Registrar**" means "le Registraire" as defined by Article 1 of the "Loi ayant Rapport aux Mariages célébrés dans l'Île d'Auregny" registered on the 1st day of October, 1923.

Repeals.

3. Section 4 of the Nursing Homes Ordinance, 1988 and section 4 of the

Residential Homes Ordinance, 1988 are repealed.

Citation.

4. This Ordinance may be cited as the Fees (Alderney) Ordinance, 1990.

Interpretation

For the purposes of this Part of this Schedule, the following expressions shall have the following meanings –

"commercial housing development" means a dwelling constructed other than for the applicant's own use and occupation,

"commercial premises" means premises designed solely or principally for use in business, trade, the professions or commerce,

"Committee" means the Policy and Finance Committee of the States of Alderney,

"constructed" and **"dwelling"** have the meanings respectively given by section 9(1) of the Housing (Control of Occupation and Development) (Alderney) Law, 1994, as amended,

"Committee" means the Policy and Finance Committee of the States of Alderney,

"Commercial vehicle" means a vehicle designed for the carriage of goods, and in the case of a car derived van, one that has no side windows to the rear of the driver's door, together with minibuses, omnibuses, tractors and self propelled plant,

"registration book" means a document of a type described in section 7 of the Ordonnance supplémentaire à l'Ordonnance ayant rapport au Trafic

Véhiculaire en cette Île ^{ba}, as amended, as the same applies to the Island of Alderney,

"unladen weight" when used to describe the weight of a vehicle, means –

the unladen weight as described in the particulars appearing in the registration book relating to the vehicle, or

where there is no registration book relating to the vehicle, such weight as the Committee may reasonably determine in respect of the vehicle.
