THE FEES (AMENDMENT) (ALDERNEY) ORDINANCE, 1997

THE STATES OF ALDERNEY, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 5th day of March, 1997, hereby order:—

1. In the Fees (Alderney) Ordinance, 1990, as amended, in Part III of the Schedule, delete the entry relating to the licensing of Passenger Boats (Alderney) Ordinance, 1954 and 1972, and substitute the following— **Amendment.**
