THE FEES (AMENDMENT) (ALDERNEY) ORDINANCE, 2008

The States of Alderney in pursuance of their Resolution of the 17th day of December 2008, and in exercise of all powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order :-

Interpretation

For the purposes of this Part of this Schedule, the following expressions shall have the following meanings:-

"commercial housing development" means a dwelling constructed other than for the applicant's own use and occupation;

"commercial premises" means premises designed solely or principally for use in business, trade, the professions or commerce;

"Committee" means the Policy and Finance Committee of the States of Alderney;

"constructed" and **"dwelling"** have the meanings respectively given by section 9(1) of The Housing (Control of Occupation and Development) (Alderney) Law, 1994, as amended;

"Commercial vehicle" means a vehicle designed for the carriage of goods, and in the case of a car derived van, one that has no side windows to the rear of the driver's door, together with minibuses, omnibuses, tractors and self propelled plant.

"registration book" means a document of a type described in section 7 of the Ordonnance supplémentaire à l'Ordonnance ayant rapport au Trafic Véhiculaire en cette Ile(a), as amended, as the same applies to the Island of Alderney;

"unladen weight" when used to describe the weight of a vehicle, means -
the unladen weight as described in the particulars appearing in the registration book relating to the vehicle, or
where there is no registration book relating to the vehicle, such weight as the Committee may reasonably determine in respect of the vehicle.

Citation and Commencement

4. This Ordinance may be cited as the Fees (Amendment) (Alderney) Ordinance, 2008 and comes into force on the 1st day of January 2009.
