The Financial Provisions (Variation of Rates) (Sark) Ordinance, 1978

THE CHIEF PLEAS OF SARK, in pursuance of their Resolution of the fourth day of October, nineteen hundred and seventy-eight, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section two and section five of the Financial Provisions (Sark) Law, 1978, hereby order:-

1. The amount of landing tax specified in the First Schedule to the Financial Provisions (Sark) Law, 1978 (hereinafter referred to as "the Law of 1978") is hereby varied by the substitution for the said amount, of the amount specified in the First Schedule to this Ordinance.

2. The several rates per gross registered ton of harbour dues set out in the right hand column of the Second Schedule to the Law of 1978 in relation to the circumstances set out in the left hand column of the said Schedule respectively are hereby varied by the substitution for the said several rates, of the several rates per net registered ton set out in the right hand column of the Second Schedule to this Ordinance in relation to the said circumstances respectively which circumstances are more particularly set out in the left hand column of the said Schedule to this Ordinance.

Citation.

3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Financial Provisions (Variation of Rates) (Sark) Ordinance, 1978.

Harbour dues

Circumstances in which vessels enter harbour or perform acts of trade in the territorial waters adjacent to this Island.	Rate per net registered ton.
Vessel entering Le Creux Harbour or La Baie de la Maseline and occupying a berth alongside a jetty whether that vessel performs an act of trade or not	1p
Vessel entering Le Creux Harbour or La Baie de la Maseline and performing an act of trade but not occupying a berth alongside a jetty or a vessel performing an act of trade in the territorial waters adjacent to this Island	$\frac{1}{2}$ p
Vessel entering Le Creux Harbour from La Baie de la Maseline and vice versa (provided it has not quit the territorial waters adjacent to this Island)	No dues payable
Vessel entering Le Creux Harbour, La Baie de la Maseline or the territorial waters adjacent to this Island on more than one occasion within any continuous period of twenty-four hours:-	
(a) <u>First occasion</u> -	
(i) if the vessel occupies a berth alongside a jetty whether that vessel performs an act of trade or not	1p
(ii) if the vessel does not occupy a berth alongside a jetty but does perform an act of trade	$\frac{1}{2}$ p
(b) <u>Second occasion</u> -	
(i) if the vessel occupies a berth alongside a jetty whether that vessel performs an act of trade or not	$\frac{1}{2}$ p
(ii) if the vessel does not occupy a berth alongside a jetty but does perform an act of trade	$\frac{1}{4}$ p
(c) <u>Third and subsequent occasions</u>	No dues payable
