The Island Development (Special Provisions) (Guernsey) Law, 1974 (Amendment) Ordinance, 1974

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section one of the Island Development (Special Provisions) (Guernsey) Law, 1974(a), hereby order:—

1. In paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section one of the Island Development (Special Provisions) (Guernsey) Law, 1974, the words “first day of March” are hereby repealed and the words “thirty-first day of December” are hereby substituted therefor. Amendment of Law.
