The Judgments (Interest) (Repeal) Ordinance, 1986

THE STATES LEGISLATION COMMITTEE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by Article 66(3) of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948(a), as amended, and in pursuance of the States Resolution of the 13th day of December, 1984, hereby order:—

1. The Judgments (Interest) Ordinance, 1978 (hereinafter referred to as “the Ordinance of 1978”)(b), is hereby repealed:

Repeal of Ordinance of 1978 with saving for existing judgment debts.

Provided that every judgment debt in respect of which the Ordinance of 1978 applies shall continue to carry interest until the same shall be satisfied at such rate as applies to judgment debts in respect of which the Judgments (Interest) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1985(c), applies and such interest shall continue to be recoverable by the judgment creditor as part of such judgment as if the Ordinance of 1978 had not been repealed.

- Construction.** 2. This Ordinance shall be construed as one with the Ordinance of 1978.
- Citation.** 3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Judgments (Interest) (Repeal) Ordinance, 1986.
- Commencement.** 4. This Ordinance shall come into force on the 17th day of April, 1986.
