**The Judgments (Reciprocal Enforcement)  
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1975**

THE STATES, on the representations of the States Advisory and Finance Committee and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section three of the Judgments (Reciprocal Enforcement) (Guernsey) Law, 1957(a), hereby order:—

1. In the Schedule to the Judgments (Reciprocal Enforcement) Ordinance, 1973(b) (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Ordinance”) immediately after the entry relating to Northern Ireland there are hereby inserted in the first column thereof the reciprocating countries and opposite thereto in the second column thereof the Superior Courts of the said reciprocating countries set out in the first and second columns respectively of the Schedule to this Ordinance.

## Section one

The reciprocating countries	Superior Courts
Kingdom of the Netherlands	The Hoge Raad der Nederlanden, the Gerechtshoven and the Arrondissementrechtbanken.
Surinam	The Hof van Justitie van Suriname, the Kantongerecht in het Eerste Kanton and the Kantongerecht in het Derde Kanton.
Netherlands Antilles	The Hoge Raad der Nederlanden, the Hof van Justitie der Nederlandse Antillen and the Gerecht in Eerste Aanleg.
Israel	The Supreme Court, the District Courts, Rabbinical Courts, Moslem Religious Courts, Christian Religious Courts and Druze Religious Courts.
