**The Jurats (Powers and Duties)
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1961**

THE STATES, on the representations of the States Advisory and Finance Committee, hereby order:—

1. The Jurats (Powers and Duties) Ordinance, 1947 (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Ordinance”) shall be amended as follows:—

Amendments
to Ordinance

- (a) the words “Income Tax Commissioner” shall be deleted and the words “President or Member of the Authority constituted under the provisions of the Income Tax (Guernsey) Law, 1950, as amended,” shall be substituted therefor; and
- (b) immediately after the word and comma “Tribunal,” there shall be inserted the following words “Chairman or Member of the Civil Service (Established Salaried Staff) Arbitration Tribunal”.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Jurats (Powers and Duties) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1961, and this Ordinance and the principal Ordinance may be cited together as the Jurats (Powers and Duties) Ordinances, 1947 and 1961.
