**The Ladies' College (Amendment)
Ordinance, 1985**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 28th day of March, 1984, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 12 of the Ladies' College (Guernsey) Law, 1962, as amended(a), hereby order:—

1. (1) The Ladies' College Ordinance, 1962(b) (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance") is amended as follows:—

- (a) section 2 thereof is repealed, together with the marginal note to that section, and the following section and marginal note are substituted:

"Principal,
Vice-Principal
and
assistant
teachers. 2. There shall be a Principal
of the College, a Vice-Principal
of the College and such number
of assistant teachers as the

Board from time to time considers necessary for the purpose of providing adequate instruction in each subject of the curriculum.”;

- (b) in sections 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 9, 10, 11, 15, 18, 20, 21 and 25 thereof, and in the marginal notes to sections 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 11 thereof, for the word “Headmistress”, wherever that word appears, there is substituted the word “Principal”;
- (c) sections 8 thereof is repealed, together with the marginal note to that section, and the following section and marginal note are substituted:

“ Vice-
Principal

8. (1) The Board shall, from time to time, after consultation with the Principal, appoint a Vice-Principal.

(2) A person appointed under this section as Vice-Principal shall, unless, in any particular case, the Board otherwise directs, during the absence of the Principal or pending the appointment of the Principal, carry out the functions of the Principal; and in any such case the provisions of this Ordinance shall apply in all respects as if any reference therein to the Principal included a reference to the Vice-Principal.

(3) Sections 3, 4, 5 and 11 of this Ordinance apply in relation to the contract of service, appointment, termination of contract of service, suspension and salary of a person appointed as Vice-Principal as if for the word "Principal", wherever in those sections that word appears, there were substituted the word "Vice-Principal".;

- (d) in section 21(5) thereof, for the word "section" there is substituted the word "subsection".

2. (1) In sections 5, 6, 10 and 15 of the principal Ordinance words importing the feminine gender include the masculine. Gender.

(2) An appointment made—

- (a) by the Board, of a Principal or Vice-Principal;
- (b) by the Principal, after the approval of the Board has been obtained, of an assistant teacher,

shall not be unlawful by reason only of the sex of the person so appointed.

(3) An appointment made before the commencement of this Ordinance which would be lawful if it were made after the commencement of this Ordinance shall not be deemed to be, or ever to have been, unlawful by reason only of the sex of the person so appointed.

Changes of
reference
and inter-
pretation.

3. (1) Any reference in any contract or other document executed before the commencement of this Ordinance, including but without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing a reference in a contract of employment, to the Headmistress or to the Deputy-Headmistress of the College shall, unless the context otherwise requires, be construed for the purposes of this Ordinance and of the principal Ordinance as a reference to the Principal or to the Vice-Principal of the College, as the case may be.

(2) A reference in this Ordinance to any other enactment is a reference to that enactment as amended, repealed and replaced, extended or applied by or under any other enactment including this Ordinance.

4. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Ladies' College (Amendment) Ordinance, 1985.

(2) This Ordinance and the principal Ordinance may be cited together as the Ladies' College Ordinances, 1962 and 1985.

(3) This Ordinance shall come into force on the 1st day of February, 1985.
