The Legal Tender (Amendment) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1985

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 30th day of January, 1985, hereby order:—

1. With effect from the 1st day of June, 1985, coins of a face value of half a new penny issued by the States of Guernsey shall not be legal tender. Half penny to cease to be legal tender.
2. In section 2(1)(d) of the Legal Tender (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1983(a), after the words “five new pence,” there shall be inserted the words “but not less than one new penny.” Amendment of Ordinance of 1983.
3. This Ordinance shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Sark, Herm and Jethou. Extent.
4. This Ordinance may be cited as the Legal Tender (Amendment) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1985. Citation.
