The Legal Tender Ordinance, 1955.

THE STATES, on the representations of the States Board of Administration, hereby order:—

1. In this Ordinance the expression “States of Guernsey notes” means notes of the States of Guernsey payable to bearer on demand.

2. On and after the first day of June, nineteen hundred and fifty-five, the following States of Guernsey notes, that is to say—

- (a) notes for one pound bearing the date of the first day of January, nineteen hundred and forty-three;
- (b) notes for one pound bearing the date of the first day of January, nineteen hundred and forty-five; and
- (c) notes for ten shillings bearing the date of the first day of January, nineteen hundred and forty-three;

shall cease to be legal tender in the Islands of Guernsey, Sark, Herm and Jethou.
