**The Licensing of Passenger Boats (Amendment)**  
**(Alderney) Ordinance, 1973**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-first day of June, nineteen hundred and seventy-two, hereby order:-

**Amendment to Ordinance of 1954**

1. The Licensing of Passenger Boats (Alderney) Ordinance, 1954 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance") is hereby amended as follows :-

- (a) immediately after the definition of the expression "boat" in subsection (1) of section one thereof there is inserted the following additional definition -

" "Braye Harbour" means the area to the southward of a line drawn from the north eastern end of the Alderney Breakwater to the Outer Grais Rock;"

- (b) the full stop at the end of subsection (2) of section two thereof is repealed and a colon is substituted therefor and immediately thereafter there is inserted the following Proviso -

"Provided that a boat in respect of which a boat licence is in force and which is let out on hire may be used, other than for the purpose of carrying passengers for payment or reward, within Braye Harbour notwithstanding that the man in charge of that boat while it is being so used is not a person in whose name a boatman's licence is in force."

**Citation and collective title**

2. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Licensing of Passenger Boats (Amendment) (Alderney) Ordinance, 1973.

(2) This Ordinance and the Principal Ordinance may be cited together as the Licensing of Passenger Boats (Alderney) Ordinance, 1954 and 1972.

**Commencement**

3. This Ordinance shall come into force on the seventh day of March, nineteen hundred and seventy-three.
