ORDINANCE OF THE STATES

Made 2nd May, 1990
Coming into force 3rd May, 1990

THE LICENSING OF PASSENGER BOATS (AMENDMENT)
(ALDERNEY) ORDINANCE, 1990

THE STATES, in pursuance of this resolution of 2nd May 1990, hereby order:-

Amendment to Ordinance of 1954

1. The Licensing of Passenger Boats (Alderney) Ordinance, 1954, is further amended as follows:-

- (a) in section 1(1), immediately after the definition of "Committee" insert:

"water ferry service" means an arrangement under which a person holds himself out as being prepared to transport people (with or without payment) by water;

- (b) for section 2(1), substitute:

"(1) A person shall not –

- (a) carry or attempt to carry any passengers in a boat for payment or reward to, from, or between, any places in the Island of Alderney; or
(b) use a boat for the purposes of a water ferry service; or
(c) hire out or attempt to hire out a boat,

unless there is in force in respect of that boat a licence (hereinafter referred to as a "boat licence") issued by the Committee."

Citation

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Licensing of Passenger Boats (Alderney) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1990.

Collective Title

3. This Ordinance and the Licensing of Passenger Boats (Alderney) Ordinances, 1954 and 1972 may be cited together as the Licensing of Passenger Boats (Alderney) Ordinances 1954 to 1990.

Commencement

4. This Ordinance shall come into force on 3rd May, 1990.
