### THE LICENSING OF PASSENGER BOATS (AMENDMENT) (ALDERNEY) ORDINANCE, 1993

THE STATES OF ALDERNEY, on the representations of the States Transport Committee, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 46 of the Government of Alderney Law, 1987(a), hereby order:—

1. In the Licensing of Passenger Boats (Alderney) Ordinance, **Amendment** 1954, as amended(b)

(a) for section 2(1)(a) substitute—

“(a) subject to the provisions of subsection (3), carry or attempt to carry for payment or reward any person in a boat sailing from any place in the Island of Alderney;”;

(b) after section 2(2) insert—

“(3) Section 2(1)(a) does not apply to the carriage or attempted carriage of a person in a boat sailing from any place in the Island of Alderney if—

(a) the boat is not normally based in the Island;

(b) its visit to the Island is in the course of a trip pre-arranged to begin and end at a place outside the Island; and

(c) that person joined the pre-arranged trip, and is destined to leave it, at a place outside the Island.

(4) For the purposes of this Ordinance a person is carried for payment or reward if, otherwise than as a member of the boat's crew, he travels

(a) in a boat let for hire or reward to him or another person; or

(b) as a passenger for hire or reward.;"

(c) in section 12 for the words following "not exceeding" substitute "level 4 on the Alderney uniform scale".

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Licensing of Passenger Boats (Amendment) (Alderney) Ordinance, 1993.
