**The Liquor Licensing (Amendment)**  
**(No. 2) Ordinance, 1957**

THE STATES, on the representations of the Island Police Committee, hereby order:—

Notwithstanding the provisions of the Liquor Licensing Ordinance, 1948, as amended, establishments, other than clubs and off licences, in respect of which there exists a licence for the sale and supply of intoxicating liquors may, on the twenty-sixth day of July, nineteen hundred and fifty-seven, be open for such sale and for such supply from half past ten in the forenoon until twelve o'clock midnight.
